To further expand trade, the East India Company (VOC) and West India Company were established in the early 17th century. LUXURY BY TRADITION

The street name Rusland is derived from the original land owner Willem Ruysch. Ruyschland evolved in the mid-16th to 't Ruslant and eventually into Rusland.

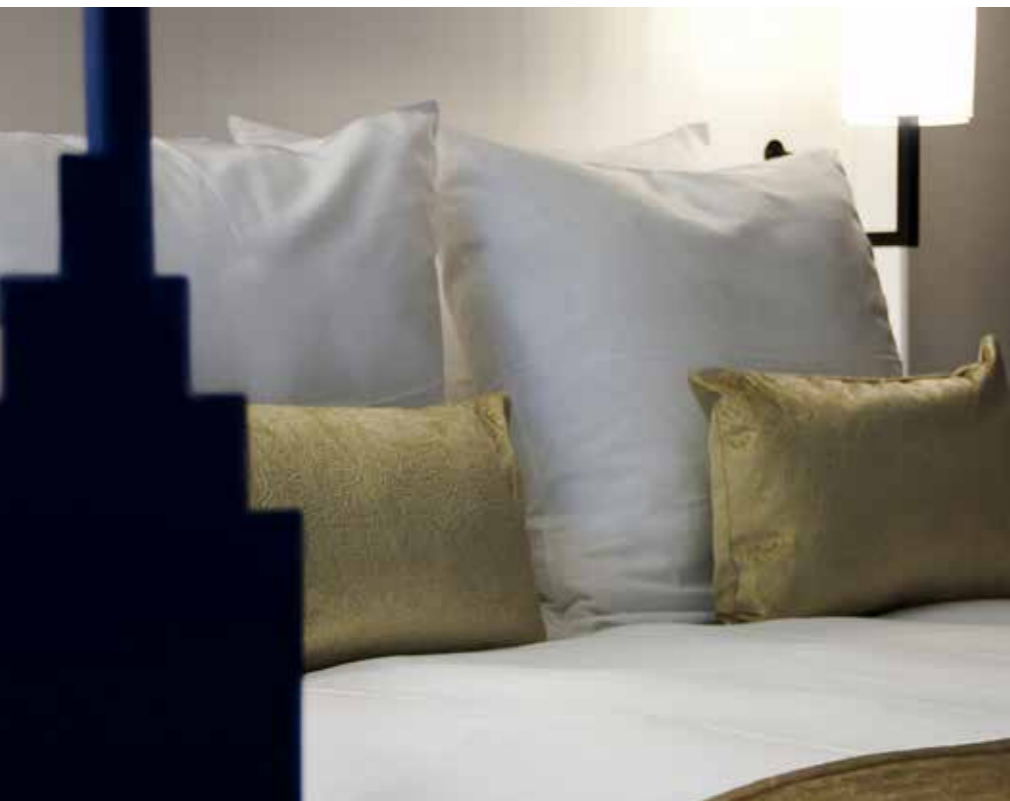


ROOMS & SUITES

RESTAURANT

Restaurant ' De Palmboom'

In Restaurant De Palmboom we use local and organic ingredients. This means we work with fresh daily goods and seasonal Dutch produce. This local character allows us to ensure the highest quality of all our dishes, from starters right down to desserts.

In 2012, after a full refurbishment of Restaurant De Palmboom, Executive Chef, Johannes Nieuwenhuizen decided to also change the direction of our kitchen. Johannes chooses to only work with local and seasonal produce which is clearly reflected in his cuisine. Not surprisingly his signature dish, pan-fried fillet of turbot with a mousseline of forgotten vegetables, is one of the most sought after items on the menu.





BAR

The Pastorie Bar

The bar was initially connected to a clandestine church in which Catholics and other religious dissenters, unable to worship in public at the time, held services.

The original church was demolished in 1954. Only the vicarage and part of the rear elevation survived and are still visible today.
