
... is located in the Eastern part of Central Europe and looks back at 1200 years of history, making it one of the oldest cities in the region.

... is famous for its breathtaking panoramic views over the city and the river Danube.


... is renowned for its thermal springs. Many local Spas feature historic Roman Greek or Turkish architecture and is home to 223 museums and galleries.

... is a hub of European culture, history, art and science.







Tinker Tailor Soldier Spy, a Cold War espionage film, is set in London in the early 1970s and follows the hunt for the Soviet double agent at the top of the British Secret service. The film was the highest-grossing film at the British box office and won a lot of the awards of BAFTA and Oscar.



# ORIGINAL DESIGNERS & ARCHITECTS

The eclectic style historic monument was built in the 19th century inspired by the Passage des Panoramas in Paris.

The magnificent art nouveau building is one of the architectural gems of Budapest, featuring ornaments in Moorish and Gothic style, colourful majolica tiles and sculptures.

Its unique design can be admired all over the building: the perfect blend between Oriental mystique and European elegance.

The original building was built in 1817 for Baron Brudern based on the plans of architect Mihály Pollack.


By the end of the 19th century almost the entire building was destroyed.

The plot was bought by the Bank of Savings in 1906. They hired architect Henrik Schmahl for the renovations, but unfortunately he passed away a few months before the renovations were finished so an other architect, Pál Lipták was the one who got the work done based on Schmahl's plans.
